- Responsibilities**
- Develop new network troubleshooting strategies to help reduce downtime and decrease maintenance costs.
 - Create rational strategies for upgrading the company's network software whenever a new update is available.
 - Construct and implement plans to ensure the company's network continues to operate smoothly in the event of a problem.
 - Purchase equipment as needed while staying under budget.
 - Stay up to date with new network technology and report this information to the DPFA.
 - Work closely with faculty to help students complete their assignments.
 - Teaching computer skills to students.
 - Manage information technology and computer systems.
 - Plan, organize, control, and evaluate IT and electronic data operations.
 - Ensure security of data, network access and backup systems.
 - Act in alignment with user needs and system functionality to contribute to organizational policy.
 - Work with providers as needed.
 - Identify problematic areas and implement strategic solutions in time.
 - Perform miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.
